CROISSY-SUR-SEINE EXHIBITION "Art and Light in Val de Seine"

September, 13-22, 2019. St. Leonard's Chapel

Nestled in a loop of the Seine west of Paris, the city of Croissy-sur-Seine is at the heart of the country of the Impressionists ... Wishing to highlight its history and its heritage, Croissy is a member of Impressionisms Routes[®] network since 2018.

The exhibition "Art and Light in the Val de Seine" will be presented in September 2019 in the Saint-Léonard Chapel, a former parish church built at the beginning of the 13th century, dedicated to Saint-Léonard-de-Noblat and included in the supplementary inventory Historical Monuments. An exceptional and prestigious showcase for this exhibition presented in May 2019 in Asnières-sur-Seine and June in Argenteuil. The nearby Grenouillère Museum recalls that this site was immortalized by Claude Monet and Pierre-Auguste Renoir, but also because his weekly ball and its noisy and popular atmosphere were beautifully described by Guy de Maupassant.

The Château Chanorier, which dominates the site, dates from the 18th century. It is home to much of the cultural life of Croissy-sur-Seine.
