Edmond Verstraeten (1870-1956), impressionist-luminist in dialogue with the creations of the students of the Academy

Edmond Verstraeten stubborn student of Joseph Coosemans (1828-1904) and therefore very often considered as an autodidact, goes to the Academy of Waasmunster with 6 unique, large paintings, exposed in dialogue with the works of the students of the Academy under the competent direction of Jean-Marie Bytebier, director and well-known artist. He is convinced that the selected works will stimulate the creativity of his students. The birthplace of Edmond, the actual Saint Franciscus school, is on walking distance in the same street.
