### Impressionisms Routes at the “Salon des Grands Voyages”. Stand and exhibition

Paris, Palais Brongniart, 18-19 November 2022

Impressionisms Routes© will be present at the “Salon des Grands Voyages” which will take place on November 18 and 19, 2022 at the Palais Brongniart in Paris. This event is a “high-end” tourism fair organized in a prestigious site near the Opera, in the heart of the French capital. It offers a rigorous selection of expert professionals, renowned for the quality of their offer and the standing of their services. It is aimed at a high-level audience in the spirit of the previous Salon organized in 2019 at the Carrousel du Louvre, in which Impressionisms Routes© participated with great success.

Impressionisms Routes© will share its ambitions and highlight its partners and the French and European Impressionist sites that are members of its network. In addition and at the invitation of the organizers, the Salon will host a significant part of the new exhibition “*Impressionism in France and Europe*” already presented in April 2022 in Evian and in June in Fontainebleau, during the Training Academy of the Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe.

**The Impressionisms Routes in Europe, Cultural Route of the Council of Europe, and its partners, will therefore benefit from exceptional visibility in a known and appreciated place.**

The Impressionisms Routes stand will be located in the main hall of the Brongniart Palace, the exhibition will be presented in this same main hall, in the immediate vicinity of our Stand. We will present a selection of reproductions of paintings on high quality canvas chosen from those composing our new exhibition created in 2022 as well as some bilingual didactic panels on Impressionism in Europe (see below).

Our Stand and the exhibition will be a privileged place for meetings and information on the Impressionisms Routes© network, the Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe and our partner Euroart. The Institute of Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe in Luxembourg and the French Ministry of Culture will participate, alongside us, in this touristic and cultural event.
