Impressionism in France and Europe

Waasmunster, Belgium, East Flanders

March 12-26, 2023

In cooperation with the Association of Friends of Edmond Verstraeten (1870-1956), a world-renowned Belgian impressionist artist, the Impressionisms Routes[®] network is organising, from March 12 to 26, 2023 at the Blauwendaal castle in Waasmunster (Belgium), an exhibition tracing the history of Impressionism in Europe.

This exhibition brings together around sixty paintings (High Quality reproductions on canvas) resulting from the cooperation between the Impressionisms Routes[®] network and numerous museums and cultural spaces in around thirty European countries, as well as around twenty didactic panels describing the Impressionist movement who largely irrigated the European continent in the 19th and 20th centuries.

An important meeting in 2023 for all those who share the need to highlight European heritage through events organized in an attractive setting and in compliance with the values of the Council of Europe and its 48 Cultural Routes which now include more than 3,000 sites in 60 countries.
